Who is this woman?

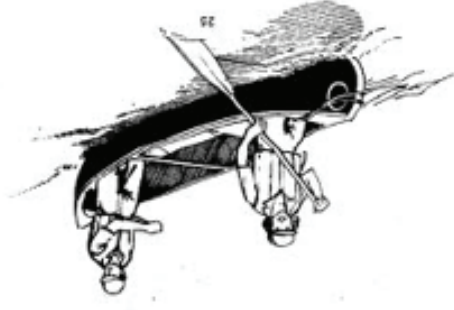
There are many possibilities! Crewdson said that even he doesn't know what happened to cause this scene or what might happen next.
