Mila Tessaieva: Promising Waters

January 22 - May 31, 2015

For over four years, photographer Mila Tessaieva has documented the transformation of the three former Soviet republics on the shores of the Caspian Sea: Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, and Turkmenistan. Her project takes the viewer on a subtle and complex journey through the promises of a new oil region, raising questions as to the relationship between the state and private identity, and the ties between past, present and future.
