

Required Spring Trainings for Student Organizations

All student organizations must attend both the Lifesavers training and the Transitions & Getting Ready for End of Year training. Lifesavers is a 1.5-hour session led by Counseling Center staff focused on recognizing suicide warning signs and supporting peers in distress; at least one E-Board member must attend, and individual sign-up is required (see QR code for registration and schedule). The Transitions training is a 1-hour session covering officer transitions and Org Renewal requirements; at least one E-Board member must attend, with no sign-up required (see QR code for schedule).
