

#### **Building Our Volunteer Ecosystem Pipelines**



#### MUAA National Board Annual Recruiting Process

#### Fall into Winter:

- Review upcoming Board vacancies and gaps succession planning
- Assess pipeline of nominees (qualified vs. unqualified)
- Score and rank qualified nominees
- Set field of candidates (4-5x #vacancies)
- Prepare intros and present to Governance Committee to determine finalists

#### Spring into Summer:

- Present full bios on finalists of Governance Committee
- Governance Committee ranks the finalists
- Recruit new members



#### Process example from a recent year with 4 vacancies:

From a candidate pool of 75 nominees:

- 19 of the 75 did not meet the Engagement Score threshold of 6.
- Another 23 were eliminated due to conflict (recently joined a campaign committee, etc.)

The remaining 31 candidates were ranked according the following factors:

- Previous Volunteer Experience (possible 5)
- Sphere of Influence and Connections (possible 5)
- Diversity and Demographic (possible -1 to 3)
- Endorsement (possible 5)
- Giving (possible 5)
- Engagement Score (possible 16)



#### Example from a recent year, con't:

The highest possible total score = 39

The highest score achieved = 34

The lowest score achieved = 15

17 nominees scoring 25-34 were presented as candidates, and subsequently winnowed to 10

10 full bios were presented in spring for Governance to rank in selection order
