**\$562.9** New gifts and pledges, 75% of \$750M goal

**53,783** Donors (44% have made their first-ever gift to Marquette)

Donors who have given 6-figure commitments; 62% were first-time major gift donors to Marquette

110 Donors who have given \$1M+ in commitments; 70% gave first 7-figure gift to Marquette









## Recent Campaign Highlights

- More than 52,000 campaign donors have supported at less than \$100K ... contributing nearly \$78M
- In academic year 2020-21, gifts of \$500 or less add up to more than \$1M!
- President's Society members supported more than 750 funds in 2020-21.
- \$200M+ raised for scholarship
- \$2M+ raised for Bridge to the Future to help hundreds of students remain at the university
- Every single dollar and gift makes a difference!




