- ACCO majors aim for ACCO 3001 in fall
- **Can select your Core Enhancement Structured Elective** of ENTP 3001, HURE 3001 or REAL 3001 (prioritize one of these if interested in declaring one of these as a major)

Non-Business Courses:

- MCC Foundations Course: Any remaining, likely CORE 1929/HOPR 2956H or ESSV1 (choices on Marquette Bulletin) (3 cr. each) *all satisfied by end of sophomore year*
- **CMST 2300:** Business Communication (2 cr.) or COMM 1100 (3 cr.) *either semester sophomore year*
- **Discovery Tier Theme Course(s)** (3 cr.) declared on CheckMarq by end of sophomore year. Watch videos about Discovery Tier on <u>Advising Central</u>, look at all options on the <u>Marquette Bulletin</u>, and take a quick peek at the <u>Business Course Chart for Discovery Tier Themes, Writing Intensive and ESSV2 courses</u>.
- Non-Business Elective(s) any course outside of business that you meet prerequisites for.
- □ STRONGLY SUGGESTED: Your fall sophomore year schedule should include 1-3 non-business courses from Marquette Core Foundations, Discovery Tier Theme, CMST 2300/COMM 1100, and/or Non-Business Electives (*Accounting majors have 12 cr. required / Non-Accounting majors have 18 cr. required*).
