CALL FOR APPLICATIONS – INTERNATIONAL VIRTUAL INTERNSHIP

Marquette University, School of Dentistry, hereby announces this Call for Applications for the selection of pre-doctoral students interested in participating in the International Virtual Internship in partnership with Sao Leopoldo Mandic Dental School, under the conditions outlined below:

1. OBJECTIVE

To select pre-doctoral students enrolled in the Marquette University (Wisconsin, USA) to participate in a two-month International Virtual Internship, including four (4) virtual meetings with faculty and students from Dentistry program at São Leopoldo Mandic College (Campinas, Brazil).

2. AVAILABLE POSITIONS

A total of 10 positions will be offered for undergraduate students.

3. INTERNSHIP PERIOD

The Virtual Internship will begin in August 2025, with meetings scheduled on the following dates:

August 29, 2025

September 12, 2025

September 26, 2025

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be currently enrolled in the 3th or 4th year of the Dentistry program at Marquette School of Dentistry.
- Show a proactive attitude, good communication skills, and an interest in international experiences.

5. APPLICATION PROCESS

6. SELECTION PROCESS

A selection committee, will evaluate applicants based on the following criteria:

- Academic transcript analysis
- Curriculum evaluation
- Demonstrated motivation and availability

7. RESULTS

The list of selected students will be announced by **August 8, 2025**, via institutional email and/or official communication channels of Marquette School of Dentistry.

8. FINAL PROVISIONS

Students agree to fully participate in the virtual meetings and assigned activities. The internship will involve collaboration with students and faculty from both institutions. At the conclusion of the program, students are required to present their internship outcomes orally and submit a written summary of the activities.

Participation will be officially certified and may count as a complementary academic activity, in accordance with institutional regulations.
