- Speak with the Legal Consultation Service, which will provide you with the name and number of an available attorney.
- Schedule an initial consultation with the attorney. They will provide information on your rights, legal options, and the costs you could expect to incur during a legal action.

All fees beyond the initial consultation are your responsibility. If you choose to retain the attorney who provided your initial consultation, you will receive a 25% discount on an hourly or flat rate.
