

Applications for Honors study abroad awards

Applications for Honors study abroad awards, to be used for programs in summer and fall 2025, are due **March 1, 2025**. They should be submitted directly through the OIE portal, and you can find more information and a link to the portal here: <https://www.marquette.edu/honors/study-abroad.php>

Students applying to one of the 6 OIE/Honors preferred programs are eligible for \$1500 awards, and can count two classes taken abroad for credit as Honors electives (sometimes there are restrictions on the second course – see the OIE website). Students applying to non-preferred programs are eligible for funding as available, but we have never had a semester where we didn't fund some students going to non-preferred programs, so please apply even if you are going to a non-preferred program. Students in non-preferred programs may count any one course taken abroad for credit toward an Honors elective. Preferred programs are listed on our website and on the OIE website, where you can also find more information about each program.

To apply for the Honors award, we ask you to write 2-3 paragraphs on the following prompt, which you will find on the OIE website as well:

--How does this study-abroad program fit into your program of study? How does it advance your academic and professional goals? The more concrete and specific you can be, the better – we want to know not only why study abroad in general is will be good for you, but why you have picked the program(s) you have and what you hope to get out of them and give to them.

In making the awards, the faculty review committee will consider this essay, your transcript (which you do not need to upload), and your OIE application.
