History: The Claretian Missionaries Western Province was established in 1908 and has administered the following Indian missions and parishes:

1927-1933 (transferred to diocesan Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church (Pima priests) and Yaqui), Tempe, Arizona 1927-1933 (transferred to diocesan Our Lady of Guadalupe Mission (Yaqui), priests) Guadalupe, Arizona 1941-1943 (transferred to Franciscans) St. Joseph Church (Navajo and Paiute), Monticello, Utah 1980-1981 (transferred to diocesan St. Catherine Church (Apache), priests) Cibecue, Fort Apache Reservation, Arizona 1980-1999 (transferred to Congregation St. Brendan Church (Paiute and Washo), of Holy Cross) Eureka, Nevada
