History: Gaetana de Thiene of Vicenza, or St. Cajetan (1480-1547), and Gian Pietro Caraffa, later Pope Paul IV (1476-1559), founded the Clerks Regular of Divine Providence or Theatines in Rome in 1524. The Theatines have administered the following Indian parish, missions, and stations in the United States:
