History:

1910-1917	Diocesan priests established and attended St. Ann Mission (Ojibwa) from St. Michael's, Mahnomen
1917-1918	Diocesan priests attended St. Ann's from St. Francis, Oklee
1918-1919	Diocesan priests attended St. Ann's from Holy Redeemer, Ogema
1919-present (Indians declined)	Became a parish; Benedictines (St. John's Abbey, Collegeville, Minnesota) administered St. Ann Church

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans:

Inclusive dates: 1915-present

Volume: Approximately .3 cubic foot
