

Philosophy, BA

The major in philosophy consists of ten courses (30 credit hours). All majors take three required courses (9 credit hours). Students taking the general philosophy B.A. (without a concentration) take seven philosophy electives (21 credit hours). Students opting to take a concentration take three courses from their selected area of concentration (9 credit hours) plus four further philosophy electives (12 credit hours). With their advisor's approval, students may choose one upper-level course outside philosophy to count either as a philosophy elective or as a philosophy concentration course.
